There are two XYZ Workshops left this year:

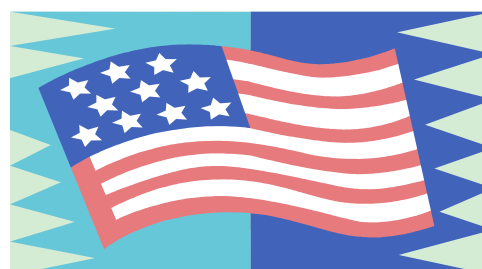
