

**2018 Criteria for Awards Celebrating:
History through Global Awareness, Government or Civics**

A Burlington County NJEA Member:

- who goes above and beyond the curriculum to engage the students in history through global awareness, government or civics.
- who brings history through global awareness, government or civics to the community and by doing so broadens the students horizons and interests in them.
- who connects the community with their knowledge/sharing of history through global awareness, government or civics and by doing so increases the support of the community for the school district and education in these subjects.

A current student or graduate of a Burlington County Public School:

- who has been or is currently involved in and makes history through global awareness, government or civics their life's work or passion.
- who is goal oriented in regard to history through global awareness, government or civics and shares that knowledge with the community.
- who is pursuing a college degree or a future education in history through global awareness, government or civics.

A Burlington County School Administrator or Community Member:

- who is a supporter of history through global awareness, government or civics in public schools.
- who is respected by the entire educational community.
- who is a visionary with regard to history through global awareness, government or civics.

An Elected Official: (local, county, state or federal level)

- who is a strong supporter of public education and history through global awareness, government or civics.
- who is visible and accessible to public school employees.
- who is a key to empowering change or transforming the community support for public education.
- who has track record of actions that show support of public education and history through global awareness, government or civics.
